Student attendance policy:

Preventive measures for student absences:

- 1-Daily close monitoring of absences for all students.
- 2-Raise students' awareness about the impact of absence on academic performance.

Procedures taken for student absence:

1-Contact the student's parents by phone and provide acceptable excuses supported by official documents.

If the student exceeds the allowed number of absences, they may face penalties such as being deprived of exams, in accordance with the applicable laws.

Permission regulations:
